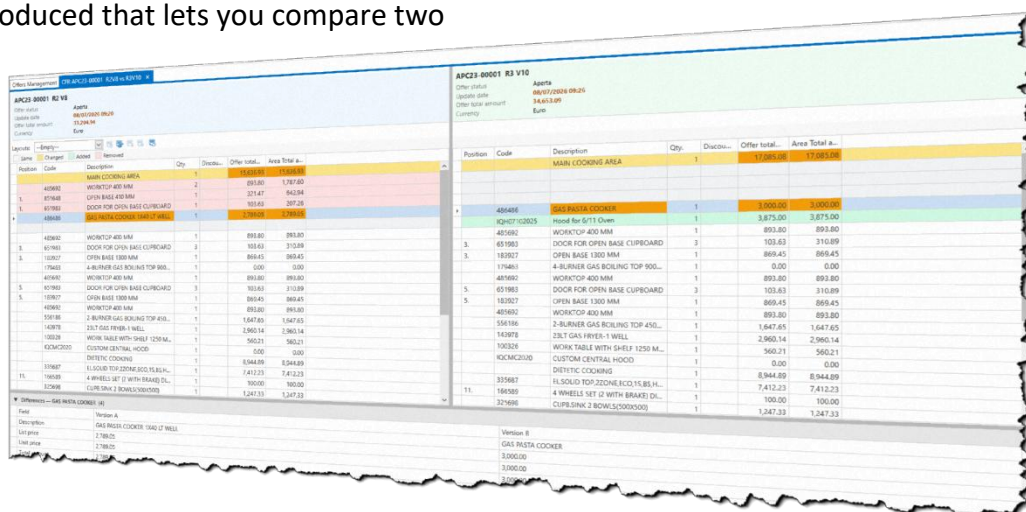

2. iQuoteWin



2.1. Comparing quote versions

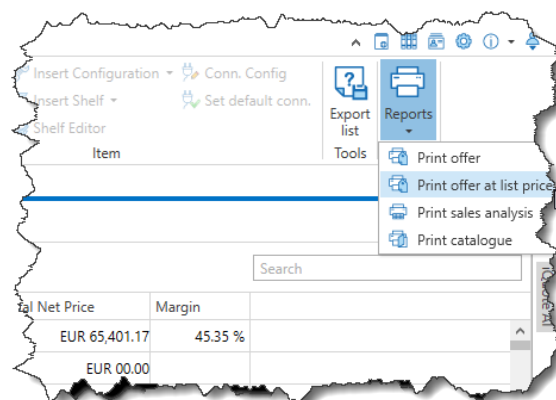
A new function has been introduced that lets you compare two versions of the same quote, graphically highlighting the differences.

2.2. Print quote at list prices

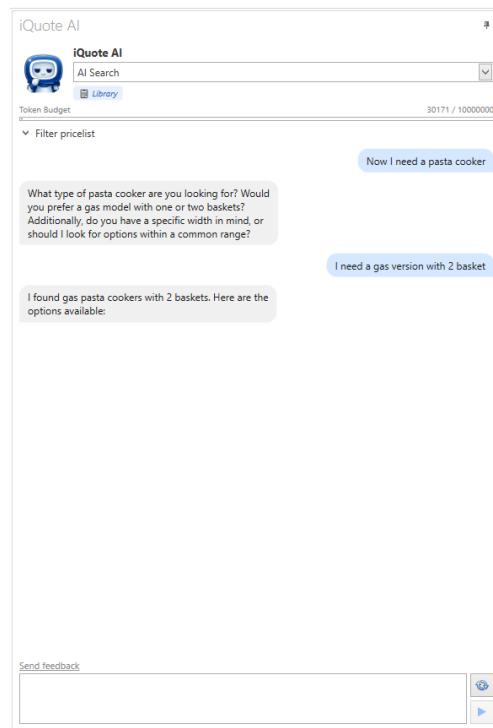
Added a new “Print Quote at List Price” button, available both from the quote tab and from the quote list, which generates a printout with pure list prices and totals, without applying discounts or markups. The original quote is not modified in any way.





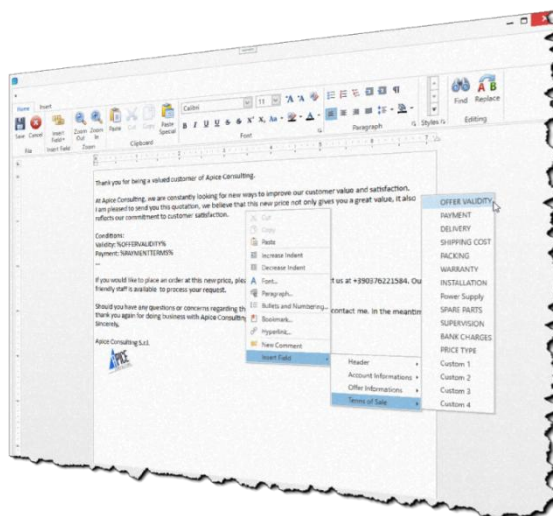
2.3. AI-powered Search

Introduction of library search using artificial intelligence models that allow searching in natural language, interacting with the AI agent that guides the user through the search process with context-related suggestions.



2.4. Terms of sale in the opening text

As already happens for the quote and customer fields, references to the terms of sale can now also be inserted in the opening/closing text.





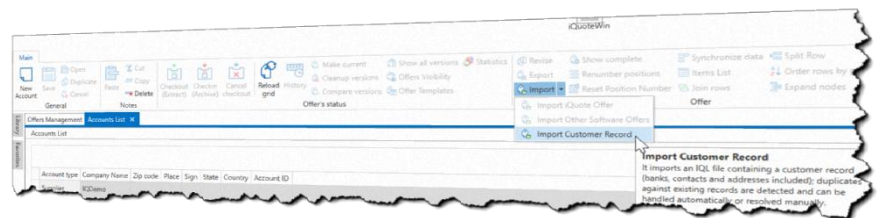
2.5. Quote template assignable to customer and difference highlighting

It is now possible to assign a quote template to a specific customer. If the quote's customer has an assigned template, any differences in discounts, markups and terms of sale compared to the template are highlighted.



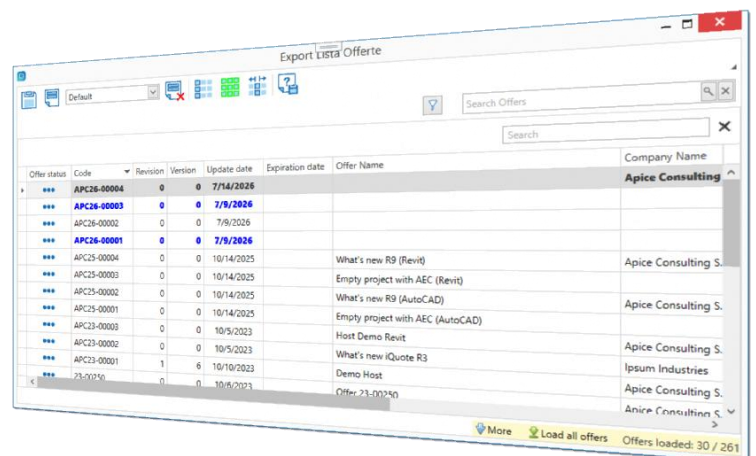
2.6. Importing customer records from other software

It is now possible to import an archive of customer records from other software. A dedicated online tool lets you convert Excel/CSV databases into iQuote's native IQL format, which can then be imported directly from the Customer Records tab.



2.7. Improved quote list export

The quote list export has been made consistent with that of a single quote, using the same configuration window, and it is now possible to export the entire list even when only a partial number of quotes is loaded in the grid.





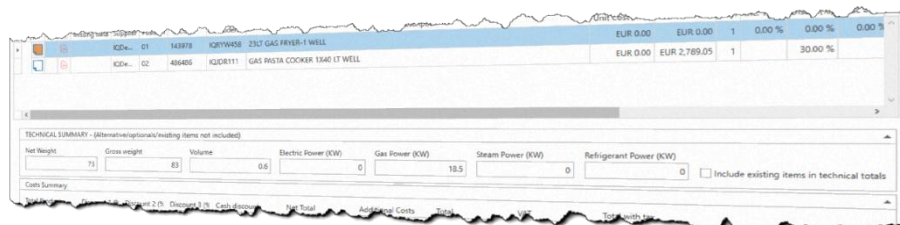
2.8. Technical totals

Technical totals are now also visible in the quote header, alongside the commercial totals.

A new option has also been

added in the print settings, “Include existing items in technical totals”, to

also include “existing” items in the calculation. In the quote printout it is also possible to individually turn the various technical data on and off, for example showing kW values without weights and volumes.




2.9. Miscellaneous

Other new features introduced in release 9.0:

- Auto-numbering savable in the quote template
- Faster, non-blocking quote import
- Move/copy quote rows in Windows style
- Renewed iQuoteWin Options window
- Custom properties: default value and export
- Customer record: duplicate prevention
- Custom library: automatic selection while browsing
- Custom library import from Excel
- Quote printout: Quote and CRM ID as separate fields
- Quote printout: customizable quote code label
- Quote printout: multiple discounts shown separately
- Quote printout: “Delivery and installation” remains visible
- Much faster quote printout with connections
- LiveUpdate: granular selection of files to download



3. iQuoteCAD

3.1. AutoCAD 2027

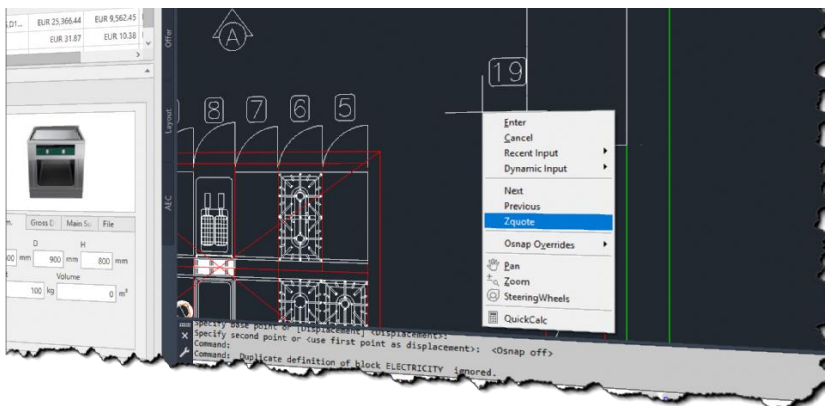
iQuote Pro version 10.0 introduces support for AutoCAD 2027 and iQuoteCAD 2027 OEM. You can now take advantage of all the benefits of the new CAD platform.

Note: due to ongoing technological development, as well as Autodesk policies, iQuoteCAD compatibility is limited to the current version plus the 3 previous versions. For this reason, starting with this version, AutoCAD 2023 is no longer supported.



3.2. Position number: custom shape and independent text color

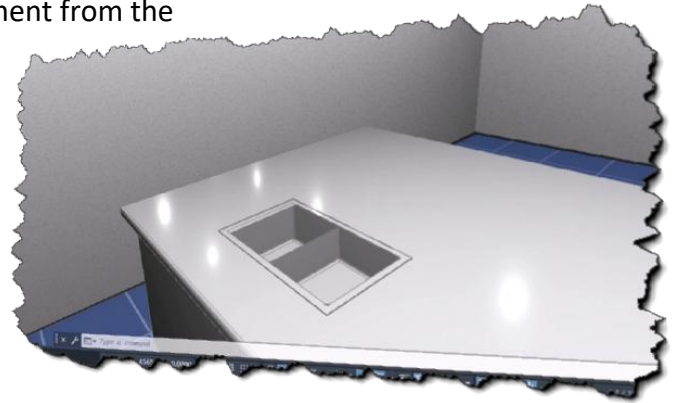
In addition to rectangular, circular and rounded outlines, a “Custom” style is now available that lets you draw a shape in AutoCAD and import it for use as the position number outline, automatically adapted to the text. It is also possible to set a text color independent of the border color, via a dedicated checkbox in the color mapping window.





3.3. Drop-in insertion from library

In addition to the ability to create cutouts on the top by extruding a 2D profile, it is now possible to create cutouts directly while inserting a piece of equipment from the library. For this to happen, a solid must have been created in the equipment file, on a dedicated layer, with the shape of the cutout to be made. During insertion, upon detecting the solid, the software asks the user whether they want to perform the drop-in by selecting the target equipment.



3.4. Miscellaneous

UCS automatically aligned to the view

Added a new general option “Align UCS to view” (disabled by default, so as not to change existing behavior). When enabled, switching to a front, back or side view using the view-change buttons automatically realigns the User Coordinate System (UCS) to the selected view, making it easier to draw on that plane. The top view is an exception and always keeps the global UCS; axonometric views are not affected by this change.

Independent position number and zone label

Right-clicking the status bar button that controls the display of the position number now opens a menu that lets you choose separately what to turn off: the position number or the zone label.

Legend text truncation

In the CAD legend, an option lets you choose to truncate text fields to a predefined number of characters.



4. iQuoteRevit

4.1. Revit 2027

iQuote Pro version 10.0 introduces support for Revit 2027 and iQuote for Revit 2027. You can now take advantage of all the benefits of the new BIM platform.

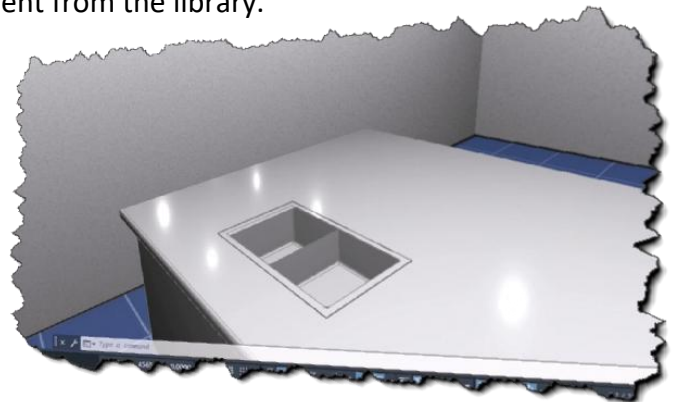
Note: due to ongoing technological development, as well as Autodesk policies, iQuoteRevit compatibility is limited to the current version plus the 3 previous versions. For this reason, starting with this version, Revit 2023 is no longer supported.



4.2. Drop-in insertion from library

In addition to the ability to create cutouts on the top by extruding a 2D profile, it is now possible to create cutouts directly while inserting a piece of equipment from the library.

For this to happen, a subtraction solid must have been created in the equipment file with the shape of the cutout to be made. During insertion, upon detecting the solid, the software automatically performs the cutout on the elements that intersect the inserted equipment.



5. iQuoteBackoffice (Server)

5.1. Re-queuing jobs that ended with an error

On the Administration > Jobs page, a job that ended with an error now shows a “Re-queue” button so you can create a new, identical job ready to be re-run, while the original one remains visible in the history with its error. The button disappears after first use, to prevent the same job from being relaunched indefinitely.

5.2. Workgroup administrator options

The workgroup administrator now has a dedicated general options page. Inside are 2 options that in previous versions were reserved for the global administrator only.

The options are: disable the image column and page size for the quote grid. The set value takes precedence over the general one, with the ability to restore the system value at any time
