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## 1. Introduction

This guide lists the new features of iQuote Pro 9.0 software.

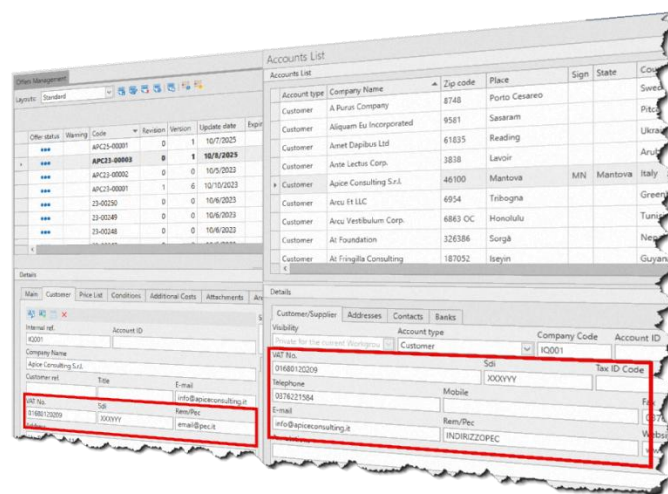

## 2. iQuoteWin



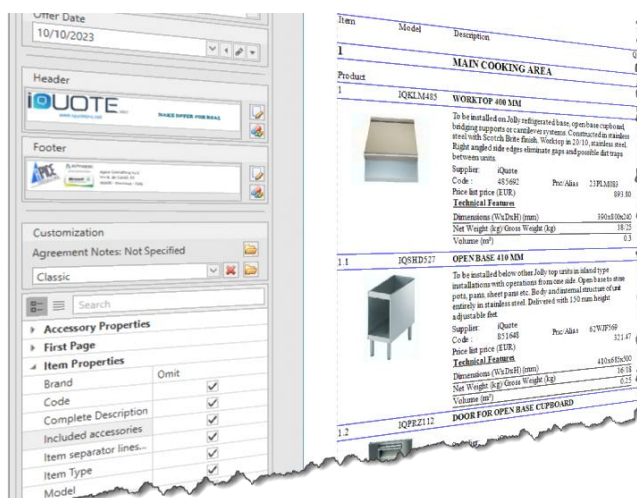
### 2.1. Customer data - Added new contact fields

Three new fields have been added to the customer records: VAT Number, Sdi Code, Rem/Pec. These fields are available both in the registry section and in the customer details of the offer. The new fields can be printed through the customization of the opening text, by adding references to the fields you wish to be printed.



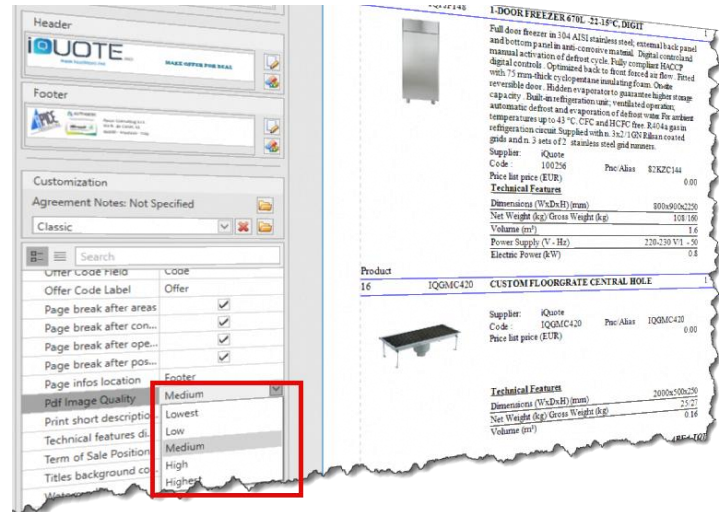
### 2.2. Offer printout – included accessories

In the print preview of the offer, it is now possible to print included accessories with the main item. Printing included accessories is optional and can be enabled in the print options within the “Item Properties” section. This setting is saved in the print templates, just like the other options.



### 2.3. Offer Printout – PDF Image Quality

New option “PDF image quality” has been added to the Layout section of the settings in Print Preview. This setting, which is saved in the print templates like the other options, allows you to preset the option available in “Export PDF document”. Until the previous version, the setting was always set to “Maximum” by default for each print job, making the exported PDF files too large. It is recommended to set it to “Medium” by default.



### 2.4. Various

Other new features introduced in release 9.0:

- Same interface in all templates saving (print, offer, configurations, opening/closing text) that allows selection between Global, Workgroup, and User templates.
- Added Brand/Supplier fields (which can be enabled or disabled using the known column chooser) in the “check catalogue print” form.
- In catalogue preview, the layout of the index page and the introductory sheet has been revised to reduce blank space and improve the readability of information.
- In offer printing, the layout of the sales conditions has been adjusted when the first page is switched off.
- In the item list (legend), the "Volume" and "Weight" fields for items have been added.



### 3. iQuoteCAD

#### 3.1. AutoCAD 2026

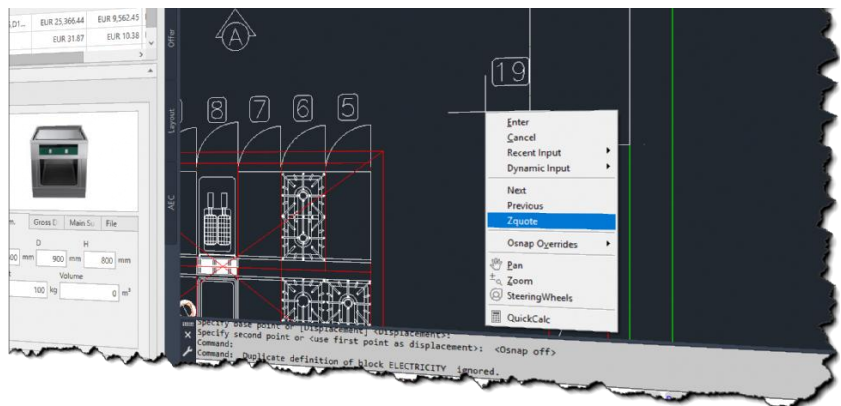
With version 9.0 of iQuote Pro, support for AutoCAD 2026 and iQuoteCAD 2026 OEM has been introduced. You can now take full advantage of all the benefits offered by the new CAD platform.

*Note: Due to ongoing technological developments, as well as Autodesk's policies, compatibility for iQuoteCAD is limited to the current version plus the three previous versions. For this reason, starting from this release, AutoCAD 2022 is no longer supported.*



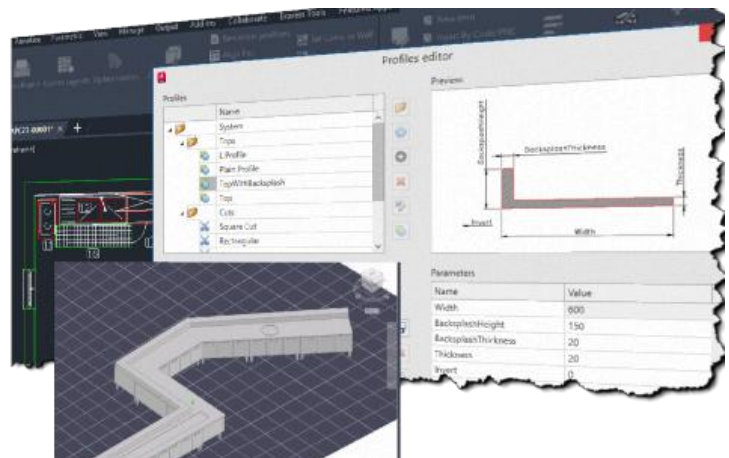
#### 3.2. Item insertion height

When inserting an item from the iQuote library, it is now possible to set a specific height from the floor, different from the one set by the active coordinate system.



#### 3.3. Sweep and cutting profiles

A dedicated set of commands has been added for the management and creation of items using a section profile and an extrusion path. A dedicated utility will make it easy to carry out cuts and openings. Typically, these commands are useful, for example, in creating worktops with corresponding sink holes, but they can be used for any shape created with a constant section along a path, such as a bar



counter. The scope of these commands is to make certain typical 3D modelling commands in AutoCAD easier and more accessible, as they are often not well known or can be challenging to use. The commands include some system profiles for creating worktops and their respective holes; however, it is also possible to create custom profiles and organize them in your own library.

### 3.4. Various

Other new features introduced in release 9.0:

- Improved leaders command: now it can display values congruent with the “unit of measurement configuration” settings of the offer.
- Added the “Volume” and “Weight” item fields to the Item List (legend)



## 4. iQuoteRevit

### 4.1. Revit 2026

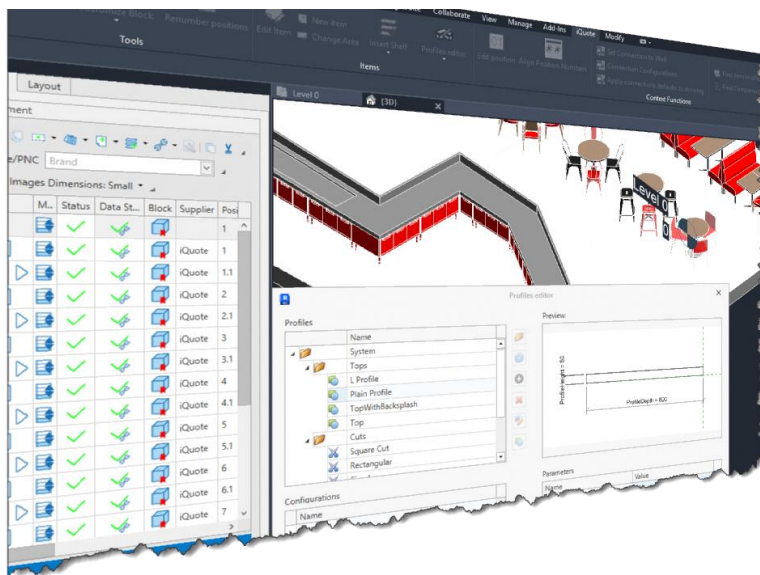
With version 9.0 of iQuote Pro, support has been introduced for Revit 2026 and iQuote for Revit 2026. You can now take advantage of all the benefits offered by the new BIM platform.

*Note: Due to ongoing technological development, as well as Autodesk's policies, iQuoteRevit compatibility is limited to the current version plus the previous three versions. For this reason, starting from this release, Revit 2022 is no longer supported.*



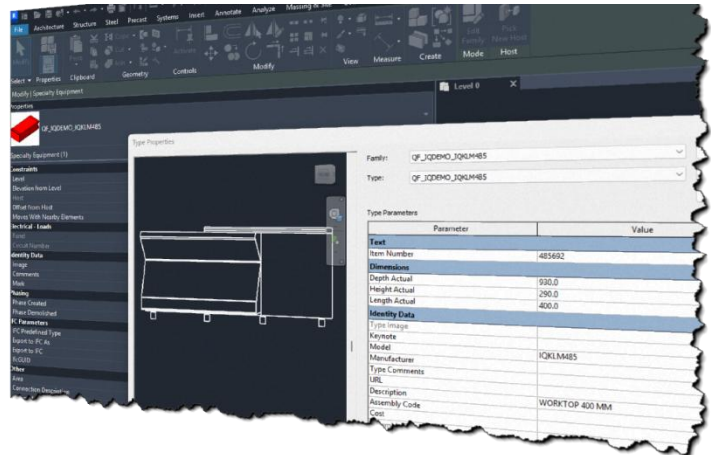
### 4.2. Sweep and cutting profiles

A dedicated group of commands has been added for the management and creation of items (families) using a section profile and an extrusion path. A specific utility will make it easy to carry out cuts and openings. Typically, these commands are useful, for example, in creating worktops with the corresponding sink holes, but they can be used for any shape created with a constant section along a path, such as a bar counter. The scope of these commands is to simplify and make accessible certain typical 3D modelling commands in Revit, which are often not well known or can be challenging to use. The commands include some system profiles for creating worktops and their respective holes; however, it is also possible to create custom profiles and organize them in your own library.



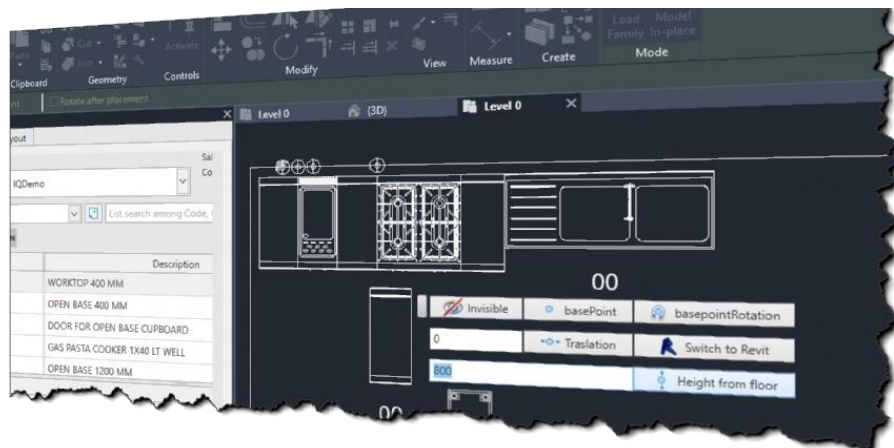
#### 4.3. Management of the Food Service Equipment category

With the introduction of the new “Food Service Equipment” category in Revit, iQuote is now also able, since this version, to manage and recognize families created using this new category. It is still possible, however, to manage families categorized as “Specialty Equipment” as in the past.



#### 4.4. Accessories insertion height

When inserting an accessory from the iQuote library, it is now possible to set a specific height from the floor, which will be assigned to the family.



#### 4.5. Position number synchronisation

It is now possible to modify the position number directly in the Revit project and iQuote will automatically synchronize the position number in the quotation.
